

Specialties

Orthopedic services include sub-specialized treatment of the spine, shoulder and elbow, hand and wrist, hip, knee, foot and ankle, and sports-related injuries.

Spine

Back pain is one of the most common medical problems in the United States. Roughly 80 percent of the population will suffer from low back pain in their lifetime. Non-surgical treatments like medication and physical therapy can help patients regain mobility and relieve pain. We also offer a comprehensive spine surgery program if all other options do not provide improvement.

Shoulder and Elbow

Because the shoulder and elbow are so frequently used, pain in these joints can make carrying out everyday tasks difficult. Elbow pain is often

caused by overuse rather than wear-and-tear, while shoulder pain commonly arises after an injury. We offer minimally invasive surgery options, as well as physical therapy, pain management, and rehabilitation services.

Hand and Wrist

Hand and wrist conditions can be degenerative, meaning that earlier treatment leads to a better prognosis. Pain may vary from a dull ache to a pins-and-needles sensation, depending on the cause. Our team develops a personalized care plan for each patient while making every attempt to utilize nonsurgical options such as anti-inflammatory medicine, ice, heat, and massage.

Hip

Hip pain is a common complaint that can range in intensity from mild to severe. Common causes of hip pain, particular in older adults, include inflammatory arthritis and osteoarthritis.

Our surgeons specialize in anterior hip replacement, a minimally invasive procedure that replaces the hip joint without cutting through muscle.

It allows patients to return to normal activity faster than traditional hip replacement surgery, with a reduced risk of post-operative hip dislocation and a shorter hospital stay.

Knee

Knee pain may arise from an injury or a medical condition, such as arthritis or gout. Early treatment is key to relieve knee pain, which can vary in location and severity. Our orthopedic specialists have several nonsurgical treatment options available, including anti-inflammatory medicine, ice, heat, and massage techniques. We also offer minimally invasive surgical procedures, as well as knee replacements, if surgery is deemed necessary.
